OFFICIAL REPORT

The 11th SNSS Annual Meeting with international participation "Ethico-legal aspect of neurosurgery in the 21st century: Challenges and opportunities" took place at the Hotel Sheraton, Novi Sad, Serbia, from October 23-26th, 2025.

This Meeting was organized as a Joint venture with the EANS Ethico-Legal Committee, Turkish Neurosurgical Society, and the Southeast Europe Neurosurgical Society - SeENS, hosted by the Serbian Neurosurgical Society (SNSS).

The Meeting has been accredited by the European Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (EACCME®) with 24,5 European CME credits (ECMEC®s) and by the Health Council of the Republic of Serbia as an International Congress.

The Meeting was held under the auspices of the President of the Republic of Serbia, H.E. Mr. Aleksandar Vucic, and the Ministry of Health Republic of Serbia and Minister of Health, Prof. Dr. Zlatibor Loncar, endorsed by the Provincial Government, Autonomous Province of Vojvodina, Republic of Serbia, and President of the Provincial Government, Mrs. Maja Gojkovic, and supported by the Ministry of Science, Technological Development and Innovations and Minister, Academician Bela Balint, and University Clinical Center of Vojvodina and Director Prof. Dr. Vesna Turkulov.

The importance of the event has been recognized by all the relevant institutions in the Republic of Serbia.

To stimulate neurosurgeons, especially young ones, 10 grants (free registration and accommodation) for the best papers selected by the Scientific Committee were provided.

The meeting was attended by total of 507 participants from 30 countries, including faculty, participants, industry partners, guests, nursing technicians, medical students and volunteers.

During the extraordinary 5 General Scientific Sessions, 4 Parallel Sessions, 3 Pre-Congress Courses, 3 Special Sessions, 1 Nursing Symposium, more than 100 experts discussed with participants the ethico-legal aspects of neurosurgery. More than 60 oral presentations within 4 Free topics sessions, and 1 Young Neurosurgeons' Forum session were presented as well.

An impressive number of attendees, number of speakers and their importance, topics and lectures, but also social program have contributed to this event to be evaluated by the participants with the highest grade.

Our thanks go to industry partners, many socially responsible companies and individuals of goodwill, who appreciate our activities and have been supporting us for years.
